Math:

Next week we will complete Ch. 3 on decimals. There will be a TEST on Wed., 11/5/14 on lessons 3.1-3.12. Please look out for the Ch. Review/Test that your child will bring home to work on Monday evening for homework. This Ch. Review/Test is due on Wed., and we will review it right before the test. By the end of next week we will begin Ch. 4 on multiplying with decimals. Please ask your child about Reflex Math. It is an online program that reviews multiplication and division facts in the format of games. Your child is expected to do 15-20 minutes of Reflex Math every Tuesday and Thursday for homework. It is a wonderful program and they can actually do it as much as they like for facts practice.

Science:

We have completed Chapter 13 on Forces in Motion. Your child will bring home his/her graded test on Monday for you to sign. Next week we will begin Chapter 14 on Changing Forms of Energy. Your child will read and learn about sound, light, and thermal energy. Next Friday 11/7/14 look out for the Study Guide/ Test Prep and Mini-Lessons. There will be a TEST on Chapter 14 on Monday 11/10/14.
