

## The Whipping Boy INDEPENDENT READING REQUIREMENT

During this grading period you will be required to read *The Whipping Boy* by Sid Fleischman and complete one independent reading activity listed below. After reading the book, you must choose ONE of the following activities to complete and turn in for a grade in Reading. Be sure to write the title of the book and the author's name on your project. If using a poster board, it should be no larger than 11x14.

## Choose ONE of the following projects:

- 1. Draw a picture of what you think the king's crest might look like. Use at least 3 symbols on the crest and write a paragraph that explains what each symbol means.
- 2. Research the Middle Ages and find out what it was like to be a prince or a king in those days. Write at least 2-3 paragraphs to explain what it was like.
- 3. Using a Venn Diagram, compare and contrast Prince Brat and Jemmy, the whipping boy.
- 4. Write a poem about Prince Brat.
- 5. Make a missing persons poster for Prince Brat and Jemmy.
- 6. Write a news article about the disappearance of Prince Brat and Jemmy.
- 7. Read a few books about the Middle Ages. Describe what people wore during that time period, what they ate, what they did for fun, etc. Write at least 2-3 paragraphs to explain what it was like.
- 8. Research what people ate during the Middle Ages, create a menu for a Middle Ages feast. Find some recipes on the internet with the help of your parent(s) and make one or two of the dishes.
- 9. Design your own Middle Ages bookmark to use while reading this book or another of your favorite books.
- 10. Make a timeline of events in the story.
